# **Monty Colour Fun Run 2025**

6 August 2025

Dear Parents/Caregivers,

This letter is to inform you about the up-and-coming Monty Colour Fun Run. This event is a P&C fundraising event aiming to raise funds for school facilities and resources. This exciting event is just over five weeks away.

Where: The Willows State School Oval

When: Friday 12 September 2025 – a timetable of events will be published closer to the event

Who: All students <u>with signed permission</u> (whole school)

**Safety:** All measures have been taken to ensure that this event is safe for all students.

The supervisors will do their best to throw the powder at the torso, however wind and other factors can cause the powder to come in contact with the face. Eye protection must be worn. Students will receive sunglasses to wear on the day, although you may wish for your child to bring their own eye protection (sunglasses or goggles).

The colour powder used in the event is non-toxic, biodegradable and environmentally friendly consisting of 98% corn starch and 2% food colouring. It will likely wash out of your child's clothing, however we recommend that your child wears a plain white shirt that you don't mind being coloured. That is what the event is all about!

Based on the toxicology profiles of the powders used, their concentrations in the formulation and the mode of use, the colour powder is considered safe for use. Students with lung issues such as asthma are advised to be careful in their decision to participate. Colours to be used: green, yellow, blue, pink, orange and purple.

Should you wish to view the ingredient listings and toxicology risk assessment of the powder, please see the staff in the Administration Office for the Safety Data Sheet.

Students are wet with water either by the fire brigade or by sprinklers to help the powdered paint adhere.

<u>Please note</u> when signing the consent, you are consenting to reading and understanding the toxicology report and making an informed decision about your child's participation in this event.

Each student will receive an ice-block at the completion of the event.

### **Requirements:**

- A white or light-coloured shirt is recommended or any old clothes from home will be suitable. Students will not be permitted to run in their Willows School Uniform shirt.
- A broad brimmed or bucket hat must be worn. Students are able to wear their school hat with "The Willows" side out
- All students must wear appropriate closed in and secure shoes to participate.
- Eye protection must be worn. Students will receive sunglasses to wear on the day.
- Students travelling on buses in the afternoon will need to change back into their uniform.
- A plastic bag for wet and powdered clothes is recommended and can also protect the car/bus seat.
- Students with light coloured hair may choose to wear a shower or swim cap to prevent the colour transferring to their hair.

**Spectators:** Parents and carers will be able to spectate within the school grounds.

Mobile phones and wearable devices with notifications enabled are not permitted to be used during any of these activities unless the student has an exemption. Students must abide by The Willows State School Student Code of Conduct 2024-2025. A copy of this is available on our website.
