Only one brief will be conducted and is scheduled for the evening of Wednesday 15 Oct commencing at 1800h in the Harry Cobby Centre.

The time/date has been chosen in order to provide an opportunity for the maximum attendance of members and their partners.

The briefs will cover off on the timely submission of AFR's, prepping personal belongings for pre-pack etc and define the responsibilities of the members and the removalists during pre-pack, uplift and down lift.

It will also cover off on the 'what if's' should any difficulties be encountered during your move with travel and/or accommodation etc.

- GP services (with a Medicare item number), including nurse practitioners offering similar services.
- Psychiatry (with a Medicare item number)
- Clinical psychology
- Counselling and psychotherapy (NEW!) with an appropriately qualified provider
- Dietitian-led healthy eating programs
- Physical activity (gym or pool memberships, and some fitness classes).
 The ADF Family Health Program also now includes lactation consultants.

Please note that GP services are unlimited. All other services are deducted from your annual allocation. Both GP and other services contribute to fringe benefits.
