The Thai government reported 4,812 confirmed deaths, 6,457 injuries, and 4,499 missing after the country was hit by a tsunami caused by the Indian Ocean earthquake on the 26 of December 2004.

On Dec. 26, 2004, people fled as a tsunami wave came crashing ashore at Koh Raje, part of Thailand's territory in the Andaman Islands and 23 kilometers from Phuket Island Dec 26, 2004

Very large tsunamis can cause damage to coastal regions thousands of miles away from the earthquake that caused them. Beaches, lagoons, bays, estuaries, tidal flats and river mouths are the most dangerous places to be. It is rare for a tsunami to penetrate more than a mile inland.
