Tackle Cyberbullying Grants Program – Apply Now!

Are you a young Queenslander or community group, P&C, or sporting group with a great idea to tackle cyberbullying? Put your idea into action.

Grants are being offered to young Queenslanders aged 10-17 and community organisations to help stop cyberbullying.

You can apply for a grant to fund a wide range of projects and initiatives, such as:

- games, activities and youth programs
- information resources, artwork, videos, films, poetry, books or t-shirt designs
- computer games, online programs, websites, apps or social media campaigns
- other creative ideas that will help tackle cyberbullying - express yourself!

Young Queenslanders can apply for grants from \$500 to \$1,500, while community organisations can apply for grants from \$1,500 to \$5,000. Applications close 23 June 2019.

Grants will be awarded to successful applicants to implement programs between 15 August and 15 November 2019.
