



There will be NO rehearsal in Week 1 (only lessons). Junior String Orchestra rehearsals will commence in the Week 1 of Term 3.






Hey Brassies,




Please ensure your child collects their instruments to take home over the holidays. We do not want them stored at school. Keep up the practise when you can!!
