English Unit 3 “Interacting with Others”

We are learning to communicate an opinion about a familiar rhyming story and identify the use of rhyme.

Students will be:

- Select and read a rhyming story.
- Write about the rhyming story.
- Share thoughts, feelings and other rhyming words with peers.

We are learning to listen to and demonstrate knowledge of rhyme through written and spoken communication.

Students will be:

- Plan for presenting a rhyme.
- Present a rhyme.
- Listen and respond to a rhyme.

Maths

We are learning to:

- Answer simple questions to collect information and make simple inferences
- Connect events and activities to days of the week
- Represent the duration of a week
- Explain the order and duration of events
- Compare objects, using mass
- Investigate connections between quantities
- Explore the concept of sharing
- Share collections
- Make equal parts of a whole
- Observe, identify and describe growing patterns

Science “Our material world”

We are learning to describe the observable properties of materials from which an object is made.

We are learning to ask and respond to questions and share and reflect on observations.

Geography “How do we care for special places?”

We are learning to investigate why the classroom is a special place, reflect on why it is important to other people and suggest ways that it can be cared for.

Design Technology “Spin It”

We are learning to design and make a spinning toy for a small child that is fun and easy to use.

Dance “Dancing Characters”

We are learning to respond to, perform and choreograph dance that represents a character.

Health “Looking out for others”

We are learning to identify and describe the different emotions people experience.

HPE- Movement “Catch that bean”

We are learning to use personal and social skills when working with others in a range of activities. We are learning to perform underarm throwing, two-handed catching and dynamic balances with a beanbag and solve movement challenges.

Music “Let’s sing and play together”

We are learning to compose, perform and respond to music using elements of music and discuss where and why people make music.
