English “Short Stories”

We are learning to analyse and compare text structures and language features authors use to influence readers. We will write an imaginative and entertaining short story about a character who faces a conflict.

Maths “Data decoder” “Rodeo Round-Up”

We are learning to:

- Interpret and use timetables and cost information to determine a travel schedule
- Perform calculations involving the four operations with whole numbers
- Solve measurement problems

Science “Making Changes”

We are learning to:

- Plan and conduct an investigation into reversible and irreversible changes
- Identify potential safety risks and suggest how these can be reduced

HASS (Humanities and Social Sciences) “Australia in the Past”

We are learning to explain the significance of key people, events, institutions and processes to the development of the Australian nation.

Digital Technology “Data changing our world”

We are learning to design and create an interactive spreadsheet and share information ethically.

Design Technology “Engineering principles and systems: Hands Off”

We are learning to design a solution to an environment’s security need and to make an electrical device that is part of the solution.

Health “Who influences me?”

We will access and interpret health information and construct a health message appropriate to our age group.

We are learning to perform, compose and respond to music from other cultures.
