It is an expectation that a<u>ll children</u> are in attendance to rehearsals as a requirement of being part of the instrumental/choral programs so we can record at our best to share with the community.

INSTRUMENTAL RECRUITING 2021

All notes for prospective instrumentalists have were sent home last Friday and are due back no later than this <u>Friday</u>, <u>23rd</u> <u>October</u>. Current instrumentalists need to have returned your continuing note by this date also so we can plan for our next intake. Testing for our potential students will happen in Week 4.

We have very limited spots for our new recruits to our instrumental program for 2021. This is determined on instrumental teachers, time allocation, school instruments and current students already in the program. Children in years 2 & 3 have received an application to apply for testing. Any child in years 3, 4 & 5 who

would like to be considered can collect an application form from the office.

Acceptance to the program is based on subject achievement, behaviour, parental support and whether or not your child is physically attributed to their chosen instrument.

Education Queensland states that only children in years 2 are invited to the strings program and years 3 - 5 for woodwind, brass and percussion. If your child in year 2 is not interested in learning a string instrument, you are asked to wait until the next intake at the end of next year.

Forms must be returned no later than <u>Friday</u>, <u>23rd October</u> so your child can sit an aural/written test in week 4.

Due to COVID, we are restricted on how testing will occur. Children interested in strings and percussion will undergo testing as normal. If your child is interested in woodwind or brass, we are hoping that your child can be physically tested on the instrument early 2021. You will be notified of your child's success by week 7 and are expected to attend an Information Evening on Tuesday, 17th
November at 6pm in TCBC to find out further information.

If your child is accepted, there will be a cost of purchasing instrumental requirements (book, folder, stand, accessories), compulsory music program fee of \$50 and an instrumental hire fee of \$100 for the year unless a violin/viola player. We look forward to seeing our prospective players join our program for 2021. If you have further questions, please come and see us.


Current instrumentalists in years 3 - 5 have received a note on whether they are continuing for 2021. It is important that this note is returned by <u>Friday</u>, <u>23rd</u> <u>October</u> or ASAP so we can allocate numbers for our 2021 instrumental program. If your child is not continuing, you must let their teacher know ASAP.


1st Year Instrumentalists

A reminder that our first year instrumentalists will be required to hand back their instruments at the end of term 4 so they are cleaned and repaired for our 2021 new recruits. Our 2020 beginner players have excelled greatly with their newly acquired skills and are sounding fabulous. We would hope that a lot of them are continuing in 2021. You will be required to purchase your own instrument as mentioned at our recruiting night and now is a good time to start looking for a good quality 2nd hand instrument.

We do have a list available on preferred brands and further information on purchasing your own instrument that is attached to the continuing note. There are a lot of good 2nd hand instruments around at a good price - you just have to find them. There are a lot of stores with various payment plans available also. Please ask your child's instrumental teacher for further information on purchasing and brands to look for if you require further information.

If you play our more expensive instruments such as cellos, tenor sax, bass clarinet, double bass, euphonium, baritone





and tuba, you will be loaned the instrument again in 2021.

If you would like further information in regards to continuing in the program or about our recruiting process, please come and see one of us.

BEGINNER STRINGS


In Week 3 Beginner Strings Students will have their lesson on Thursday the 22nd Oct, NOT Monday 19th.



Welcome to term 4!


This term all brass groups are expected to work hard and try to improve their playing skills using 2 tracking systems to understand your performance goals:




