The Willows State School strives to create a safe and positive learning environment for all students. As a school community, we work together to enable students to engage in learning through our Positive Behaviour for Learning Plan (PBL). The primary goal of this plan is to promote consistency in our high standards fostering our school rules of being Safe, Respectful and Responsible. The students learn about PBL through fortnightly lessons that target our behaviour expectations. These lessons also feature at our whole school and year level parades. The school has signage in each area to inform and remind the students of The Willows expectations.

Our school has 3 Positive Behaviour Mascots, who were devised, named and voted on by the students of 2017. Waldo, Olive and Willow are seen around the school in many different locations. Their names bring the **WOW** to our school!

* RESPECTFUL * RESPONSIBLE Students, classes and cohorts are continually acknowledged and rewarded for displaying Safe, Respectful and Responsible behaviours throughout the year. Please regularly ask your child if they understand the expectations of our school and celebrate the rewards your child receives.

Our school expectations are printed on signage around the school for teachers, students, parents and visitors. This is so we have a calm and consistent environment conducive to learning.

Rewards

Students have a goal to collect at least, 75 stars each 5 week cycle and then are able to attend that 5 week cycle reward activity. Also if they have not had a major behavioural incident in the term they can attend an End of Term celebration. The teachers and students are currently deciding on the mid-term and end of term celebration for their year levels.



- Students receive stars for modelling the school high expectations
- Stars align with the classroom management chart
- Students need 75 star stamps at the end of Week 5 to earn the 1st reward
- Students need 75 stamps by the end of Week 10 to earn 2nd reward
- Students can receive a stamp at any time during the day for great classroom behaviour

Fortnightly Focus

Each fortnight there is a PBL focus across the school to support our students behaviour for learning. These lessons are taught by the classroom teacher and staff refer to the focus across all areas of our school.

Parades

The Willows State School has Year Level Parades once a week. These parades focus on the high standards of behaviour expected and are a celebration of Excellent Learning, Behaviour and Attendance. The students will receive certificates to acknowledge their achievement. We invite parents/carers to come along and join the celebration of student success.

Across the term there are also whole school Parades when the students come together as a whole school, this reinforces the expectation for ceremonies and commemorations. These will occur approximately every 3 weeks according to the Term plan.
