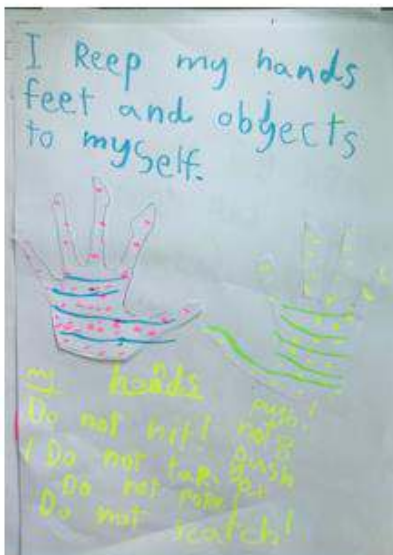


PBL Fortnightly Focus
