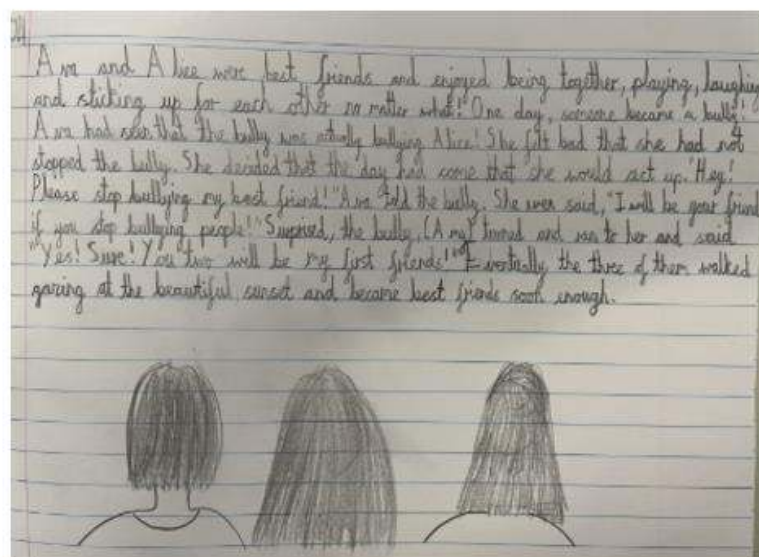
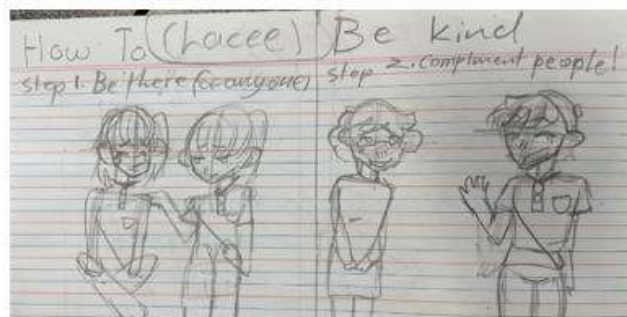
Rewind. Be Kind.
