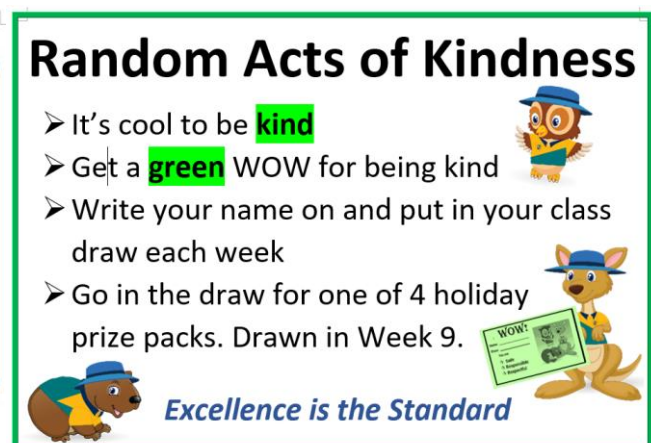
Random Acts of Kindness

- Give someone a high-five ✓

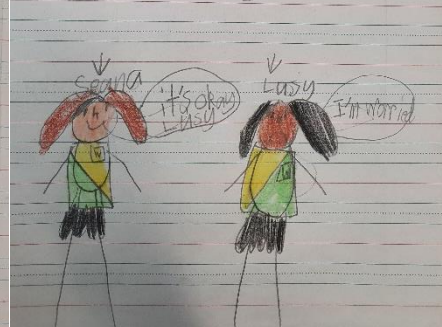
The three ways I am going to show kindness this week are:

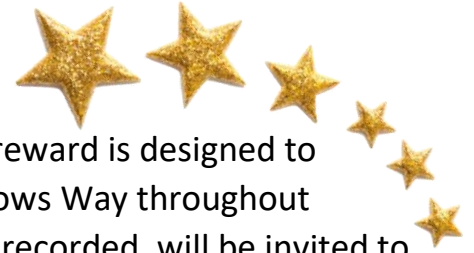
Collective Leadership - Student Council
