On Thursday 3rd March and Friday 4th March our Year 5 students (and Year 6 students in 5/6F EVA) will be visited by *Hands on Wildlife*. Our Science unit for this term investigates the structural features and behavioural adaptations of animals. An animal handler from *Hands on Wildlife* will focus on structural features and behavioural adaptations of different animals including two geckos living in different environments. This activity has been assessed as being low risk.

What students will be doing:

- The animal handler will bring several animals and discuss the physical and behavioural adaptations of these animals
- The animals will include a knob tail gecko and a left tail gecko
- The animals may include: spinifex hopping mouse, squirrel glider, blue tongue lizard, shingle back lizard and crocodile
- Students will have the opportunity to handle animals under supervision
- Students use text and diagrams to make notes/complete activity focussed on the two lizards which live in different environments
- The animal handler will answer student questions
