

Prep/Yr 1: Term 1

English Unit 1 - 'Enjoying Our New World'

Students are learning to talk about their favourite stories.

Students will be choosing a story they have read or listened to and discuss the following:

- The story
- The main character/s
- Feelings about the main character/s
- Likes and dislikes about the main character/s
- An event from the story
- Feelings about the story
- Ideas in the story connected to our own experiences

Year 1 students

Students are learning to comprehend and respond to imaginative texts (picture books).

Students will be listening to stories and writing about the following:

- Purpose of imaginative texts
- Comprehending stories
- Making connections to personal experiences

Maths Unit 1

Prep students are learning to:

- Group familiar objects based on similar characteristics

Students will also be learning about:

- Representing numbers from 1-10
- Investigating patterns in the environment
- Investigating and compare the size of objects
- Matching numerals to quantities
- Ordering and sequencing everyday events

Year 1 students are learning to:

- Classify outcomes (chance)
- Understand teen numbers
- Investigate data representations

Students are also learning about:

- Measuring length using formal units
- Representing and solving addition problems

Science Unit 1 – 'Exploring Our Living World'

Students are learning to represent, share and reflect on observations about the needs of living things and how an environment can affect them. Students will also learn how to ask and respond to science questions.

HASS (Humanities and Social Sciences) Unit 1 – Families and Celebrations

Students are learning to explore important events celebrated in our lives, and identify how people and objects help them to remember these events.

Digital Technologies

Students will be learning to recognise and explore digital systems and describe their purpose. They will be designing a code for Bee Bot.

Health Unit 2 – 'I can Do It'

Students are learning to identify different settings where they can play safely and identify and describe the different emotions people experience.

HPE- Movement 'Let's Get Moving'

Students are learning to perform a range of fundamental movement skills and apply them to solve movement challenges. They will apply practices to keep ourselves safe, including following rules in simple activities and games.

The Arts

Students are learning to respond to, devise, choreograph and perform dance and drama that uses storytelling.

Music 'Music in our New World'

Students are learning to compose, perform and respond to music using the stimulus of different texts.
