

Year 1- Term 1

English Unit 1 - 'Exploring How a Story Works'

Students are learning to comprehend and respond to imaginative texts (picture books).

Students will be listening to stories and writing about the following:

- Purpose of imaginative texts
- Comprehending stories
- Making connections to personal experiences

Some books we will be reading: Rainbow Fish, Big Rain Coming and The Very Itchy Bear.

Maths Unit 1

Students are learning to:

- Classify outcomes (chance)
- Understand teen numbers
- Investigate data representations

Students are also learning about:

- Measuring length using formal units
- Representing and solving addition problems

Science Unit 1 - 'Living Adventure'

Students are learning to describe changes in their local environment and how different places meet the needs of living things.

Students will be responding to questions, making predictions and sharing their observations with others.

HASS (Humanities and Social Sciences) Unit 1 - 'My Changing Life'

Students identify, describe and sequence personal and family events and describe continuities and changes in aspects of daily life over time.

Health Unit 1 – 'A Little Independence'

Students are learning to describe changes that occur as they grow older and recognise how strengths and achievements contribute to identities.

Technologies

Students are learning to collect and represent using a digital system, manipulating data in a creative way and justifying the choices they make.

HPE- Movement 'Playing with Balls'

We are learning to send, control and receive balls in a variety of movement situations and test alternatives to solve movement challenges.

The Arts

Students are learning to respond to, and choreograph and perform artworks involving dance and drama.

Music 'Musical Stories'

Students are learning to compose, perform and respond to music that tells a story.
