Year 3 - Term 1

English Unit 1 - 'Analysing and Creating Persuasive Texts'

Students are learning to examine ways persuasive language features are used to influence an audience.

Throughout this unit students will:

- Read a range of persuasive news articles
- Identify the persuasive language that has been used to persuade the audience to a point of view
- Write persuasive paragraphs to convince an audience of their point of view on a range of topics

English Unit 2 - 'Investigating Characters'

Students are learning to write an imaginative narrative on a familiar theme of 'friendship' that develops characters.

Throughout this unit students will:

- write using the narrative structure (orientation, complication, resolution) to express and develop in some detail events, ideas and characters.
- o understand how language features are used to link and sequence ideas.
- o understand how language can be used to express feelings on topics.
- o comprehend literal and implied meaning in a text and identify and explain the author's use of language.

Maths Unit 1

Students are learning to:

- Represent 3-digit numbers in numerals, words and base 10 blocks
- o Locate 3-digit numbers on a number line
- Compare and order 3-digit numbers
- o Represent addition and subtraction problems
- o collect and interpret data from simple chance experiments
- o use simple strategies to reason and solve a measurement inquiry question.

Science -'Spinning Earth'

Students are learning to explain the cause of everyday observations on Earth, including night and day, sunrise and sunset, and shadows, and use diagrams and other representations to communicate ideas.

HASS (Humanities and Social Sciences) Unit 1 - 'Our Unique Communities'

Students are learning to conduct an inquiry to answer the following question: *How and why are Anzac Day commemorations significant for different groups?* Students will pose questions, locate information, sequence information and identify a point of view.

Health Unit 1 - 'Good Friends'

Students are learning to recognise strategies for managing change and identify influences that strengthen identity. Students will investigate how emotional responses vary and learn about interacting positively with others.

Technologies - Unit 1

Students will be creating a game using a visual programming language.

The Arts - Unit 1

Students are learning to respond to, devise, choreograph and perform dance and drama.

Music Unit 1 - 'Songs of Australia'

Students are learning to compose, perform and respond to Australian music.
